





Our Daily Itinerary

Day 1, Monday, January 13: Depart the USA

We depart the USA en route to Rome with complimentary meals and beverages served on board our international flight.

Day 2, Tuesday, January 14: Arrive Rome / Transfer to Assisi

We arrive in Rome and are met by our Catholic Travel Centre tour manager, who will accompany us throughout our journey. We board a motor coach and make our way to Assisi. Dinner is served at our hotel. (D)

Day 3, Wednesday, January 15: Assisi: Visit of the town

This morning, after breakfast, we visit this quiet medieval town, imbued with the mystical spirit of one of the most fascinating characters of history. St. Francis was born the son of a wealthy cloth merchant, and for the first 25 years of his life lived the high life, drinking and partying with his friends, and dreaming of being a Prince and Knight. While going off to war in 1204, Francis had a vision that directed him back to Assisi, where he lost his taste for his worldly life. From then on, his

sometimes harsh experiences moved him to live the rest of his life in poverty.

St. Clare was born in Assisi in 1194. Like her mother, Clare was very devout. When Clare was 12, her father wanted her to marry a wealthy young man - she begged to be 18 first. When she turned 18, she heard Francis preach and ran away to become one of his first followers.

We begin with Mass at the Basilica of St. Francis. Then we meet a local guide for a guided visit of the Basilica of St. Francis, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, constructed over the tomb of St. Francis.

We continue our walking tour of the town including the Chiesa Nuova, built over the home of Francis' family and the Basilica of St. Clare, where St. Clare lies in repose.

Here we see the original 'San Damiano' crucifix that spoke to Francis. We continue on to the Church of St. Mary Major where, some 800 years ago, St. Francis dramatically renounced his father's wealth, disrobing in the presence of his father and the bishop. The church contains the remains of Blessed Carlo Acutis. (May 3, 1991 – October 12, 2006), a remarkable young man beatified for documenting Eucharistic miracles worldwide. He was beatified on October 19, 2020. Lunch and the rest of the afternoon are on our own. Dinner is included at our hotel. (B, D)

Day 4, Thursday, January 16: Assisi / Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels / Florence

This morning we check out from our hotel and travel to the village of Santa Maria degli Angeli, where we visit the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels containing the Porziuncola, a small chapel called the "Blessed Virgin Mother of God." The chapel deserted and in ruins, was repaired by St. Francis and the friars. This tiny church rests inside the larger Basilica, like a ship in a giant bottle. Nearby is the site of Francis' death. We celebrate Mass at the Basilica and then continue to our hotel in Florence for check-in and dinner. (B, D)

Day 5, Friday, January 17: Florence: Visit of the City & leisure

This morning, we start with Mass at the Church of Santa Croce, housing the tombs of Michelangelo and Dante among other famous figures. Then we meet our local guide to begin our walking tour, encompassing the Baptistery of San Giovanni, one of the oldest buildings in Florence. It is dedicated to John the Baptist. The octagonal building is famous for its gilded bronze doors,

particularly the Gates of Paradise by Lorenzo Ghiberti. We also visit the Cathedral, and the renowned Piazza della Signoria. Lunch and the rest of the afternoon are on our own. The afternoon provides an opportunity to explore the iconic Ponte Vecchio. Dinner is served at our hotel. (B, D)

Day 6, Saturday, January 18: Florence / Rome: St. Paul Outside the Walls & Abbey of Tre Fontane

Today we check out from our hotel and travel to Rome. Upon arrival in Rome we visit the Basilica of St. Paul's Outside the Walls, housing the Tomb of St. Paul the Apostle, affectionately known as the Apostle of the Gentiles.

After his execution and burial in Rome in the 1st century AD, Saint Paul's followers erected a shrine over the grave. Early Christians frequently visited the site to honor the great Apostle. The first church on the site was, founded by Emperor Constantine in 324. In 386 Emperor Theodosius began the construction of a much larger basilica. According to the inscription on the triumphal arch, it was consecrated in 390 and completed in 395. Although heavily restored, the present Basilica looks much the same as it did in the 4th century. We enter through the Holy Door and celebrate Mass.

We also visit the Abbey of Tre Fontane, the traditional site of Paul's execution. Paul was executed in the aftermath of the fires that demolished Rome in 64 AD. The Annals of the Roman historian Tacitus describe the persecution of the Christians, who were blamed without grounds for the fire that destroyed three-quarters of the city. We check in to our hotel in Rome for dinner and the rest of the evening. (B, D)

Day 7, Sunday, January 19: Rome: Panoramic tour of Ancient Rome & historic walking tour

This morning after breakfast, we board our motor coach and enjoy a panoramic tour of Ancient Rome driving by the Roman Forum, Palatine Hill, the Arch of Constantine, Circus Maximus and the Coliseum, named in reference to the "colossal" statue of Nero that at one time stood at the entrance.

Then our local guide leads us on a walking tour of historic central Rome, starting with a visit to the Trevi Fountain, where we toss our traditional three coins into the fountain to make our three wishes - one for love - one for money - and one to return to Rome. We continue our walk to view the Pantheon, originally built to honor all the gods

of Ancient Rome as well as the Piazza Navona, with its beautiful fountains. We gather at a local restaurant for our included lunch.

In the afternoon we visit the Basilica of Santa Maria Sopra Minerva, housing the tomb of the St. Catherine of Siena. Along with St. Francis, St. Catherine is a co-patron of Italy. Here we celebrate Mass. We return to our hotel and dinner and the rest of the evening are on our own. (B, L)

Day 8, Monday, January 20: Rome: St. Peter's Basilica, Scavi tour & Vatican Museums

Early this morning, we enter through the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica. We will celebrate Mass here at the Basilica. After Mass, our guide shows us the Basilica. With Michelangelo's dome, the Basilica is the most prominent building inside Vatican City. Here we see the Papal Altar covered with the sumptuous bronze baldachin by Bernini, and the apse, aglow with golden mosaic. In addition to many sculptures and monuments by Bernini and other great artists, we see Michelangelo's famous statue of The Pieta. There are over 100 tombs located within the Basilica, including 91 popes.

Later, we have the rare privilege of a guided visit and tour of the underground excavations (Scavi) beneath St. Peter's Basilica. (*subject to confirmation*). After enjoying an included lunch at a local restaurant, we have some time at leisure in the Vatican area.

Early this evening, we enjoy a special semiprivate, after-hours visit of the Vatican Museum and Sistine Chapel (*subject to confirmation*). Dinner is on our own tonight to explore the local restaurant scene. (B, L)

Day 9, Tuesday, January 21: Rome: Basilica of St. John Lateran & Holy Stairs

This morning we visit the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran, entering through the Holy Door. It is the cathedral of the Diocese of Rome, and the seat of its Bishop (the Pope). Built by Constantine, and consecrated in 324 A.D., it is the highest ranking of the world's basilicas, and called "the mother of all churches." Its dedication has even been given a feast day (November 9) on the Church's liturgical calendar! Here we celebrate Mass. The Lateran Palace, next door, was the home of Popes for many years, until the Vatican was built, and at least 18 Popes are buried in this Basilica. We will also visit the nearby Scala Santa, purportedly

the stairs which Christ climbed prior to his condemnation by Pontius Pilate. Balance of the afternoon is at leisure. Dinner is included at our hotel (B, D)

Day 10, Wednesday, January 22: Rome: General Papal Audience, Basilica of St. Mary Major & Our Lady of Perpetual Help


After an early breakfast, we transfer to St. Peter's Square for the General Papal Audience (subject to Pope's schedule). We have some time on our own for lunch and shopping in the Vatican area.

In the afternoon we enter the Holy Door for Mass at the Papal Basilica of St. Mary Major, the largest church in Rome dedicated to our Blessed Mother. The present church was built around 440 AD. It is one of the four historic Major Basilicas of the papacy, part of the papal territory beyond Vatican City. It was here that Pope Francis celebrated his first Mass. Our next stop is the Church of St. Alfonso Liguori, where we will see the icon of Our Lady of Perpetual Help. Tonight we gather for a special farewell dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 11, Thursday, January 23: Return to the USA

This morning we transfer to Rome airport for our return flight home.

Note: While no changes are anticipated, there may be unforeseen occasions when certain alterations become necessary to this itinerary, either due to changes in airline schedules or for other reasons.

How to Register: Registrations are processed in the order received and many groups fill up quickly, so please register soon as space on this pilgrimage is limited. Deadline for initial registration is June 15, 2024. To attempt to register after this date, inquire first to learn if any space is still available. To make your reservation, you will need to complete Catholic Travel Centre's (CTC) Registration form and send it along with your \$500 per person non-refundable deposit (payable to Catholic Travel Centre). If you were registered to travel to the Holy Land this year and received your \$500 travel voucher, you need to include that voucher along with your registration form and deposit.

In addition to these items, you will need to complete the waiver form and the release form sent to you by the Diocese of Cleveland. Please send all these items to:

Once Ms. Conley receives all three of your completed forms (CTC Registration form, the waiver form and the release form from Diocese of Cleveland) and your deposit, she will forward your Registration form and deposit directly to Catholic Travel Centre for processing. Catholic Travel Centre will send your invoice to you via postal mail within two weeks of CTC's receipt of your completed registration form and deposit. Final payment is due directly to Catholic Travel Centre 120 days prior to departure, by **September 15, 2024**.

VOUCHER: If you were registered to travel to the Holy Land in 2024 and received your \$500 travel voucher, please enclose the voucher when mailing your completed paperwork and initial deposit. Your voucher amount will appear on your invoice as a credit toward your final balance due; voucher cannot be applied toward your initial registration deposit.

TRAVEL PACKAGES: We offer two types of tour packages and two forms of payment:

Packages

- 1) Full Package (including airfare)
- 2) Land Only Package (travelers make their own airline arrangements).

- 1) Discount Price (payment by check or money order)
- Standard Price (payment by credit or debit card).

Your Price Includes: Airfare based on non-refundable, restricted economy class group fares only on regularly scheduled IATA carrier from Cleveland airport (CLE); first class hotels or best available accommodations (all with private facilities); sightseeing; meals per itinerary (B, L, D); all gratuities and is based on a minimum of 35 fully paying passengers per motor coach. Notice On Etias (European Travel Information And Authorization System)

The European Union plans to implement ETIAS Travel Authorization for U.S. Citizens wishing to enter a member country of the European Union (*Italy included*). At the time of creating this brochure, the start date for this ETIAS program was not available. Catholic Travel Centre will continue to monitor the situation and advise passengers accordingly. Passengers will be responsible for securing and paying for their own ETIAS Authorization online (about \$10 per person) once the program officially begins.

HEALTH DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS: Please refer to the Terms and Conditions of this brochure for guidance on documentation requirements.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: Once your initial registration deposit is processed by CTC, you will receive an email with information on suggested travel insurance options. CTC strongly suggests the purchase of travel insurance to help protect your investment in the trip and to help provide medical coverage outside the United States. We also strongly suggest you purchase the broadest coverage available with the least amount of exclusions. Because some travel insurance plans contain time-sensitive benefits, we encourage you to do your research and purchase insurance in a timely manner.

AIRLINE DEVIATIONS, SEATING, UPGRADES & FREQUENT FLYER

BOOKINGS: Deviations from the group flight itinerary, specific seat assignments, seat upgrades, and bookings using "frequent flyer" program points are not possible within the terms of our group airline contract. If these items are important to you, we advise you register for the "Land Only" package.

WALKING: Please note, this journey involves considerable walking on cobblestone streets and uneven pavement and requires being on your feet more than usual. You should be in good physical condition to enjoy this pilgrimage to its fullest.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS -

ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS & CONDITIONS: Any payments made by a Traveler or on behalf of the Traveler ("Traveler", "you") to Catholic Travel Centre (CTC) toward any CTC tour shall constitute acceptance of all Terms & Conditions provided herein.

PAYMENT TERMS: All payments shall be made on the dates indicated in the payment schedule, noted in the Registration Information section. Late payments are subject to a non-refundable \$150 fee, and may result in cancellation. A Traveler registering within 120 days prior to departure must provide full payment by cashier check, plus a non-refundable late registration \$150 fee. CTC reserves the right to cancel registrations not paid in full 105 days prior to tour departure and to charge fees per the Cancellation Policy. A non-refundable \$75 fee is charged on all returned payments. Travelers agree not to dispute any credit card charges associated with this trip before contacting CTC first to resolve their concerns. CTC retains the right to dispute any chargeback that is improper and recover any costs, including attorney's fees related to improper chargebacks. Additionally, in the event of an improper chargeback, CTC retains the right to cancel any travel reservation related to that improper chargeback NOTE: Credit card charges will not show as "travel expense" on your credit card statement, but will appear as "specialty services", "shopping" or another designation.

CHANGES IN PACKAGE: After initial invoicing, changes from the air inclusive package ("Full Package") to "Land Only" or vice versa are subject to a non-refundable \$75 per person per change fee. Changes must be requested in writing to CTC at least 130 days prior to departure date (subject to availability). Late requests to change the package may not be accommodated.

CHANGES IN FORM OF PAYMENT: To change from Cash Discount to Standard pricing, the difference between prices plus an additional \$75 fee applies. After a Traveler's credit card has been charged for any portion of the tour, s/he is ineligible for the Cash Discount Price.

PARTIAL PACKAGES NOT AVAILABLE: Tour Packages are offered as described in this brochure, at the stated price. Partial package purchase is not available.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION POLICY: CTC's cancellation policy is in effect upon first payment toward any CTC tour. A Traveler's cancellation must be provided in writing either by email, fax, or registered mail to CTC. The cancellation by the Traveler is effective on the date of the cancellation email, fax, or date of postmark. The Traveler forfeits the following fees to CTC based on the date of cancellation notice: anytime up to 120 days prior to departure, \$500 fee; 119 to 90 days prior to departure, \$500 fee plus 25% of Land Cost plus the full cost of all of the Traveler's airline travel (including airfare and related taxes, fees, surcharges); 89 to 60 days prior to departure, \$500 fee plus 50% of Land Cost plus the full cost of all of the Traveler's airline travel (including airfare and related taxes, fees, surcharges); 59 days or fewer, all payments by Traveler made to CTC are forfeited, and there are no refunds. In event of individual cancellation, no name changes or substitutions are permitted. No shows: Passengers who do not show up for the group's departing flight (or land only passengers who do not show for first hotel night) will be considered as tour cancellations: their airline and/or hotel reservations will automatically be cancelled and cannot be reinstated.

PRICES: If the group does not reach the size advertised, the price or programming will be adjusted accordingly. Pricing is based on exchange rates and fares applicable at the time of quotation and is subject to change. Fuel surcharges are subject to increase up to 30 days prior to departure.

PASSPORT: A valid passport is required of all U.S. citizen passengers. Travelers of other nationalities should inquire with the appropriate embassies, and such Travelers are responsible for securing their own visas if required in addition to their valid passport. Travelers' passports must be valid for six (6) months following the return date of the trip. CTC expressly denies any responsibility for any losses incurred due to insufficient validity of a Traveler's passport.

HEALTH & MEDICAL CONSIDERATIONS: The Traveler is responsible for identifying and securing any health/medical related documentation required by the airlines and/or countries visited on the itinerary, and CTC bears no responsibility for the passenger not providing the required documentation. If a country requires proof of COVID vaccination and/or a negative COVID test, it is the responsibility of the passenger to secure such documentation within the required timeframe as a condition for joining this tour.

The Traveler agrees not to hold CTC, our suppliers, or the group leaders responsible should they contract any illness during or after their travel. It is highly recommended Travelers be medically healthy and physically capable of significant walking. CTC tours involve international travel to foreign countries that have different standards of accessibility than U.S. law. Transportation services, which are provided by third parties, as well as visited sites and accommodations, which are not owned, leased, or controlled by CTC, may not be compliant with accessibility standards required by U.S. law. CTC cannot guarantee wheelchair,

motorized scooter, or walker accessibility during a trip and does not provide individual assistance to Travelers. If a Traveler requires special individual assistance, the Traveler, not CTC, is responsible for bringing and paying for a capable companion willing to assist the Traveler. CTC assumes no responsibility for Travelers' inability to fully participate in the tour, nor does CTC provide any refund for non-participation in any part of the tour.

CTC cannot evaluate the adequacy of the prospective insured's existing insurance coverage. If you have any questions about your travel protection, call your insurer or insurance agent or broker. Declining to purchase an adequate travel protection plan could result in the loss of your travel cost and/or require more money to correct the situation. You also acknowledge that without this coverage, there may be no way to recoup any losses, costs, or expenses incurred. If you choose to travel without adequate coverage, CTC will not be liable for any of your losses howsoever arising, for which trip protection plan coverage would otherwise have been available.

STATE DEPARTMENT & OTHER AGENCIES' ADVISORIES: The State Department (www.state.gov), the Center for Disease Control (www.cdc.gov), and other government departments and agencies may issue travel advisories or warnings for one or more of the destinations visited on tour, and such advisories or warnings may even be in effect at the time of your registration for this tour. Should you choose to travel to a country that has been issued a travel warning or advisory, CTC will not be liable for damages or losses that result from travel to such destinations. CTC cannot change its Cancellation Policy or Terms & Conditions based on any such warning or advisory or the occurrence of any terror, health, pandemic, or other incident in one or more of the places this tour is scheduled to visit. All cancellation penalties remain in full force and effect. It is your responsibility to be aware of any and all requirements for admittance to a country or state, including COVID-19 requirements. Certain countries have a requirement for foreign visitors to have valid medical insurance on entry. CTC cannot be held responsible for denied entry if the Traveler is unable to provide details to authorities of insurance or denial of entry for any reason.

ITINERARY: The itinerary presented in this brochure represents what CTC is planning for this trip; however, the itinerary is subject to final confirmations and changes in local schedules. While no changes are anticipated, CTC, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to change the itinerary, as it deems necessary or advisable. CTC is not responsible for costs or fees related to itinerary changes necessitated by changes in an airline's schedule or other arrangements not made through CTC.

FINAL TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Travelers receive travel documents by email approximately two weeks prior to departure. Bulk items such as luggage and names tags will be shipped by CTC to group leaders for distribution.

ACCOMMODATIONS AND MEALS: Accommodations are based on double/ twin rooms with private bathroom facilities. A limited number of single rooms are available and are subject to a single room supplement fee. If no roommate is available for you, or your roommate cancels prior to departure, a single room supplement surcharge applies. Triple rooms are not always available and are discouraged because of cramped quarters; no price reduction for triple rooms. Meals are either menu of the day or buffet. Included meals are as shown in the itinerary (B=Breakfast, L=Lunch, D=Dinner).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: All airline tickets are round-trip economy class and non-refundable unless specifically stated. Any cancellation, itinerary change, or failure to use confirmed space is subject to penalties and/or fees levied by the airline at the time of ticketing. Airfare, airline carrier, and airline schedules are subject to change without notice. Airline fees and fuel or security fee surcharges (if any) occurring after the date of brochure publication are the responsibility of the Traveler.

AIRLINE DEVIATIONS, SEATING, UPGRADES & FREQUENT FLYER BOOKINGS: The following are not possible within the terms of CTC's group airline contract: specific seat assignments, seat upgrades, services deviating from the group itinerary, booking using frequent flyer points and airline credit. If these items are important to you, CTC advises you to register for the "Land Only" package. Additionally, CTC does not record Traveler frequent flyer numbers, TSA numbers, or Global Entry numbers. Passengers must submit this information on their own at the airport at the time of check-in.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS (CONTINUED) -

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Travelers arranging their own airline ticket must meet the group at the first hotel of the itinerary.

BAGGAGE & PORTERAGE: Baggage is at Traveler's risk. Traveler should confirm the checked and carry-on baggage specifications with the air carrier specified in Final Travel Documents. Any checked baggage fees, if applicable, are not included in the tour price. Checked baggage is limited to one bag per person (subject to change by airline) and must adhere to airline specifications. Porterage for one piece of luggage is included at hotels; no porterage at airports.

NOT INCLUDED IN THE PRICE: Passports, visas, meals and beverages not mentioned, extras beyond standard menu, baggage fees, telephone calls, laundry, medical tests, and other items not explicitly stated as included.

PHOTOGRAPHY: CTC may take photographs or film of its trips and trip Travelers, and Traveler grants CTC express permission to do so and for CTC to use such for promotional or commercial use without payment of any fee or royalties. CTC has the unrestricted right to use and/or copyright and/or publish aforementioned photographs or film in any media for advertising or for any other lawful purpose. Traveler waives any ownership or publication right in connection with photographs or film taken by CTC.

PARTICIPATION: CTC reserves the right to decline to accept or retain any Traveler on any of its tours if, in its sole discretion, it deems accepting or retaining any such Traveler as being detrimental to the tour. No refunds shall be made for any unused portion of the tour in this instance, and any expenses related to early return home are the sole responsibility of the traveler.
