Our county needs an emergency shelter service for women. Currently, Geauga County homeless women without children to care for have nowhere to go. GFRM has city approval to use the home at 341 Washington Street, Chardon, Ohio as a women's emergency shelter. We will be able to provide immediate shelter for up to four women at this location.

Project Evaluation — What are your specific	Staffing – The board is looking to hire an additional staff member as the women's program manager. Our staff are trained onsite and through our affiliation with other rescue missions that have many years of experience. As an organization we have existed for over ten years and built a reputation of compassion and excellent service for those in need. We strive to glorify God in all that we do; therefore, we strive for excellence in how we operate our facility and who we serve. GFRM's goal for our guests is to overcome the life choices or circumstances that have led to them being homeless. As each guest works through the program their progress is tracked, and success is celebrated. We also follow-up with our guests when they transition out.

Attached are estimates for the repairs and upgrades for the women's shelter. Some items on the list are required by the city before we can get an occupancy permit. These items will take priority over the other renovations. We are going to be using a lot of volunteers and will seek to get as many supplies donated as possible. Your funding will go a long way towards helping complete this project. We are partnering with N.O.A.H. in connection with the remodel work that needs to be done. They are donating skilled workers to help with the remodel work. WGC funding will cover the cost of the following items: Sidewalk and Apron - \$6,700.00 Tree Removal for Sidewalk - \$4,670.00 Emergency Exit lights - \$875.00 Create separate bedroom - \$4,300.00 Total =\$16,545 These items need to be finished before we can get the occupancy permit. Our goal is to have the facility remodeled and upgraded by the end of 2025.
