Currently we have over 50 parishes partnering with Catholic Charities in some way!

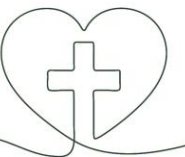

Important Dates

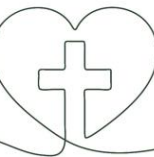
- **Late December** 6,000 letters and calendars went to our leadership donors
- **January 28th** 140,000 donors will be mailed
- **April**- joint letter from pastors and Bishop will be sent
- **June 7 and 8**- In pew follow up
- **July**- Calls will be made to our donors who have not given yet
- **September** –letter of the year is sent
- **November** –last letter of the year is sent
- During this time we also send out emails, texts, and social media tools



Date	Communication Channel	Topic
February 1/2 (Leading up to In-Pew Weekend)	Bulletin and Pulpit	Encourage participation during In-Pew by using the bulletins provided in the parish packets. Start mentioning the appeal at the pulpit and in your Prayers to the Faithful
February 8/9 (Announcement Weekend)	Email/Social Media	Send an email to all your parishoners reminding them about in pew weekend. Encourage them to go to your social media to see the video posted about Catholic Charities
Ongoing	Social Media	Promote Catholic Charities Put the Video out there!

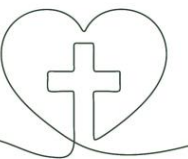
Day of To Dos

- Have audio-visual equipment ready
- Give everyone an envelope that comes to Mass
- Each priest should have the script in the manual and use it as a *guide* for their homilies for in pew weekend
- Pastor invites and walks people through envelope completion
- Envelopes are collected
- Pray for Catholic Charities and the donors in your petitions



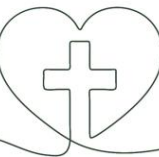
Something Different That Works

- St Clarence has used FlockNotes for a call to action from the pastor
- St Mary in Chardon sends the video in their Friday email, posts to their social media, and has it on their website
- St. Bridget of Kildare does a compelling in pew homily while also playing the video at Mass
- Other Diocese are
 - Provides children's donation box
 - Posts pastors on video encouraging attendance/donations/etc and posting to social media

Date	Communication Channel	Topic
Week of February 17 and Ongoing	Email/Social Media	Thank parishoners for their generosity to Catholic Charities Show the thank you video on your social media and email Share with them their parish progress and encourage them to check it out on the webpage
Week of February 17	Mail	Via UPS or FedEx please send back all the in pew envelopes to our gift processor in Albert Lea, MN
Ongoing	Social Media	Promote Catholic Charities Post the Video



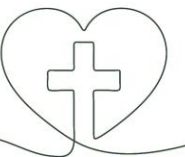
We Need You!

GOALS!!!!

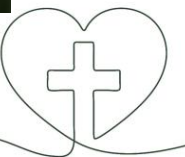
2025 goal went up \$300,000 from 2024 to \$15.3 million

For 2025 we took the total pledge dollars of each parish for last 3 years ('22-'24) to come up with an attainable goal for each parish

100 parishes will see a decrease in their 2025 goal from 2024

87 parishes will see their 2025 goal increased from 2024

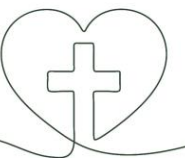

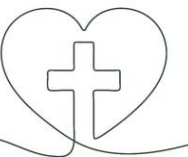
