Questions & Answers about FreeWill

Can I use FreeWill to support for my parish after I am gone?

Yes, legacy gifts are a meaningful, effective way to create a lasting legacy. [FreeWill](#) has a section that allows for you to create your Catholic legacy that lasts beyond your lifetime. Get started here: <https://www.catholiccommunity.org/legacy/freewill>.

Is my estate big enough to leave a planned gift?

Yes! Gifts of any size are deeply appreciated. Many people choose to leave a percentage of their estate, which scales up or down with your estate size.

Can my gift remain anonymous?

Yes! Knowing in advance about your intentions is quite helpful, but you are welcome to not disclose your legacy gift. You can still remain anonymous to the public, even if you notify the pastor about your gift.

Does it cost anything to plan my estate?

The Catholic Community Foundation has partnered with FreeWill to help you make a will or trust at no cost to you. You can use this to complete your plans, or you may choose to use the same tools to get your affairs in order before visiting an attorney (who is likely to have a fee associated with finalizing your plans).

Can I edit my documents after I'm done?

Yes. You are always free to revise or update your estate plans.

Is my private information secure with FreeWill?

Yes! FreeWill will never share your personal information without your permission.

How much does it cost to use FreeWill?

The Catholic Community Foundation has partnered with FreeWill to make it easier for our community to create their Catholic legacy. Using this online tool, you can write a legal will for free and protect your blessings, while including the necessary language to create an eternal legacy gift in your plans. This resource takes 20 minutes or less and can be paired with an attorney for more complex estates.
